Summary: (machine translated)

Perfect alternative canyon when all the other canyons have too much water. The water level can be assessed from the parking lot.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

Take the D 1205 to Oex and park opposite the closed restaurant Chez Arlette. You can also park a second car (see coordinates).

Approach: (machine translated)

Either follow the trail from the upper car a little below the slope across the meadows into the forest. There you will immediately find the streambed. (2 minutes)

Without a second car, follow the road south from the parking lot. Follow the fourth road to the left (Route de la Rippaz). At the upper hairpin bend, a track starts which initially runs parallel to the neighboring stream (Nant de la Rippaz) and then leads up to the left into the forest. Simply follow this ascent until you reach the road with the upper parking lot (white container). (30 minutes)

Tour: (machine translated)

After a short rappel along the stream, the first short rappels follow, which are partly on single hooks, partly on tree slings with rings. Some abseils lead over several steps! You quickly reach the first high waterfall: C 15, 2 bolts far back on the right, C 25, 2 bolts on the left, C40, chain anchor on the right. Further rappels from trees (emergency exit via a path on the left) lead to a water tap and the next and last high rappel: C 5, 2 anchors left, C30 chain anchor left front

Return: (machine translated)

The last high rappel is followed by a few meters through the stream. You then reach the garden of a house on the right. Although you can simply get out here, you are probably entering private property. It is better to continue through the stream for another 20 meters and then get off at the bridge.
