Summary: (machine translated) Forest gorge, scenically attractive, less sporty. Ideally combined with Hinterer Kreidengraben (2x6 rappel) after a lot of rain. Both are N-facing with small water catchment area.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Small catchment area, ideal to do during/after rain.		
Access: (machine translated) From Germany: Pass Mittenwald on the B 2 to Scharnitz, from Austria from Innsbruck past Seefeld on the B 177. Turn southeast of the Isar bridge, cross under the railroad and after 400m turn left to park your car in the large parking lot (fee - anno 2017: 6 euros). Alternatively park at Banger Park, a hiking trail starts behind the cemetery.		
Approach: (machine translated) From the parking lot, we first follow the Hinterautalstraße for a few meters, which leads into the upper Isar valley. However, we immediately turn right onto the road that leads south into the Eisack district. At the foot of the slope, the road bends to the right and we take the path that curves up the slope to the left. We cross a stream and then take the "Teufelssteig", which leads away from the slope in a southerly direction. At an altitude of 1180m, we cross "Die erste Klamm" (designation from the digital AV map 2010) and reach the Teufelslochklamm (AV: "Die ander Klamm") at an altitude of 1250m. This is the (upper) entry point (1h 15 min.). You can also enter at 1180m - lower entry. To do this, follow the forest road straight ahead after the first stream crossing. We come to a point where a hiking trail branches off to the right ("Tafeleweg", in AV 2010: "Hochwaldweg"). It intersects the forest road once again and crosses "Die erste Klamm" at an altitude of 1090m (AV map 2010). In the further ascent, we approach the edge of the Teufelslochklamm gorge and then descend steeply into the bottom of the stream (lower entry, 1180m altitude -50 min.). Alternatively take the hiking trail behind the cemetery.		

Tour: (machine translated)

1) 20m tree, lb, double cordelette w ring.

Trail and possible exit.

Graffiti of a little devil (old 8mm, missing).

2) 6m 1 bolt, lb.

DC, walk.

3) 20m 1 bolt w ring (far, marked w.wood, in flow), lb.

DC, walk.

4) 6m 1 bolt, lb.

DC, walk.

5) 8m, 1 bolt, rb (double drop possible)

DC, walk.

6) 18m, 1 bolt, 1 abalakov w.ring, lb, highlight, nice view.

Continue down, exit before the bridge, or ideally continue into Hinterer Kreidengraben, exit rb on a steep hunters trail.

Return: (machine translated)

From the bridge over "our" stream we follow the "Isarsteig" to the left, finally steeply down to the houses of Scharnitz. At the foot of the slope we take the path that takes us westward again to the district of Eisack. Once on the tarred road, we take the approach path in a northerly direction back to the parking lot.

I couldn't find an anchor at the third rappelling point; I think I'm blind... I ended up climbing up to a tree on the orographic right. The canyon isn't pretty—lots of wood, crumbly rock, and downclimbs that, in my opinion, aren't suitable for beginners. No continuous narrow sections. The Jägerpfad trail at the exit is clearly visible on the orographic right and easy to follow. I was able to follow the trail up to the old 1150 and complete the tour to Hintere Kreidegraben. Complete rebolting with m10 ss, only the first abseil is from a tree, (new redundant corde with ring). Also added new anchors to protect the downclimbing. Kindly provided by www.canyonzone.com Continued into Hinterer Kreidengraben for another 6 abseils. Ideal after rain (with a flash flood warning) as the catchment area is very small. Collector/beginner canyon. Did not verify the mini-waterfall at the end as i exited after 6 abseils to connect with Hinterer Kreidengraben (steep hunters trails, clearly visible on the right bank). 20m tree, lb, double cordelette w ring Trail, possible exit Devil graffiti (old 8mm, missing) 6m 1 bolt, lb (Deliberately damaged bolt thread so they cannot remove) DC, walk 20m 1 bolt w ring (far, marked w wood, in flow), lb DC, walk 6m 1 bolt, lb DC, walk 8m, 1 bolt, rb (double drop possible) DC, walk 18m, 1 bolt w.ring, 1 abalakov w.ring, lb, highlight of tour Exit rb on a hunters trail to continue into Hinterer Kreidengraben

Beginning of long walking passages, partly in bedload, partly in small, beautifully polished chutes. Shortly before crossing the hiking trail, 1st abseil from a 20m tree. Then again running route, downclimbing again and again, slightly tricky. 2. from driftwood 6 m 3. from a bad anchor 10m 4th from block 3 m 5th from a good ring bolt 15 m Sun in the canyon again and again at noon. Wood in places. Not very long but away from the hustle and bustle. (machine translated)
