We leave towards La Pesquera about 2,5kms from the crossroads, we will find a parking on the right (in google maps P2 or P3 of Pesquera).

We leave the parking lot crossing the river in the direction of Peñagalera until almost reaching the ridge at about 800m altitude. Here we find a fork that we will take to the left, much less marked path that goes over the cuts of Arrancapets channel. About 150m later we have a channel on the left with a cairn indicating the descent.
