Summary: (machine translated) rappel canyon		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) B 178 to Lofer, at the central traffic circle direction St. Martin, after ~200 m left over the Saalach and immediately right over Scheffsnoth to the inn Knappenstadl.\nApproximately 30 m before the parking lot there is space for 3 cars on the right side of the narrow road.\nPlease park in such a way that traffic is not obstructed or ask the inn to park in their parking lot.		
Approach: (machine translated) Follow the road behind a barrier and ~80 m after a tool shed follow the hiking trail to the Kematsteinalm. Here beautiful view of the waterfall. Continue in the direction of Scheffsnother Alm. After the height is reached and you walk parallel to the stream, descend to it without a path.		
Tour: (machine translated) Very slippery, also tolerates more water, intermediate stand (after 45 m, ~6 m r. of the fall line) in the wall for currently 2 people - expandable. \nHigh risk of falling rocks in the pool of the 80 m waterfall: climb out to the right to pull off and wait.		
Return: (machine translated) After the two short rappel after the high WSF. and ~100 meters of boulder terrain, before a small break left in the forest descend 100 meters in altitude near the stream until you come to another ~3 m high WSF, on the right side of which a path is visible.\nAfter a few meters you can see an overgrown forest road. Follow this downhill - crossing the stream 2 times - until a signpost points to the Knappenstadel. Here in ~5 min. to the car
