<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) No details		
<b>Hydrology:</b> (machine translated) Small catchment area, discharge is falling faster than Rybi. Should be considered in early summer.		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) Idem Rybi Canyon: Cross Lauterbrunnen, 15m after the bridge over the Weisse Lutschine take the road to the left and park at the exit in the parking lot next to the sports field.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) Access can be made by train from Lauterbrunnen to Wangen. From there it is about 20 minutes to the entry (downhill). Optimal public transport tour and the way to Wangen is included in the GA travelcard.		
See approach to the Rybi Canyon. When you cross the Rybi Canyon, follow the path and 200 m after the Mättlibach you come to a meadow on which you descend on the right side for about 50 m and then go over the fence into the small forest. Over a "tuff, moss, boulder field" you can descend to the stream, cross the stream briefly and descend opposite on the bank to the first rappel in the middle on a stone.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) The descent begins directly at C130, starting with rappel RD on AN and arriving at the start of a 10 m waterfall in a chute. The relay of the first long length is located behind the chute in RG (old status is RD). From there, a 55m long pitch leads to a "new" belay on the LEFT (old belay is on the right) and then on to an 85m long pitch. At the foot of the C130 you immediately come to a short and beautiful indentation.		
Exit options at the foot of the C130, no exit into the mini gulch.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) Leave RG to reach the old railroad line again, cross the bridge over the Mättli and turn left onto a path immediately after the bridge. Cross the fields in the direction of the parking lot. Do NOT cross the fields in the middle when the grass is high, so as not to trample the forage, but keep to the edges.

Ascent by train and then hiking trail . After crossing the Mättlibach stream, go all the way down by a field, then over the barbed wire fence into the forest and steeply down almost to the edge. There slight climbing tracks to the right to the stream. Partly very tricky Descend again on the orographic right side in the forest. Then a central abseil ring - 10m After that just about 55m to the belay (after about 20m there is also an orographic belay on the right which we skipped). Either two new rings on the left or 4 older, somewhat rustier bolts on the right (still recommended for larger groups). Below then a very nice incised canyon with several rappels to about 20m, then exit to the bridge It rained very heavily the day before and also after our ascent - but the river has not really changed (conditions can be seen very well from Lauterbrunnen) (machine translated)
