<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) North-facing limestone tour, some very beautiful rocks. Best done in May when it is still nice and sunny but the snow at the top is not yet melting at full speed.		
<b>Hydrology:</b> (machine translated) Small catchment area, but glacier on top. So the amount of water changes greatly on warm days.		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) Park at the col du Pillon.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) The hiking trail goes up directly at the col, then take the turn-off to the right after the hollow.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) Smaller gulches with 2-3 waterfalls followed by the C90, then another slab before the rock gets very light and makes nice pools.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) Turn right onto the hiking trail.
