Summary: (machine translated)

Gimbach is an easy hiking canyon with some small jumps and short swimming passages through large pools. The water is extremely cold and clear, but not a problem due to the short time spent in the canyon. More attention should be paid to the underground, because it is quite slippery. Otherwise, this tour is also suitable for beginners.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

By car on the Westautobahn exit at Regau, just before Bad Ischl a road branches off in the direction of Weißenbach am Attersee. Follow this road until after about 6km you will see a sign on the right side of the road with the inscription "Gimbach-Kaskaden". There is also plenty of parking here.

Approach: (machine translated)

Follow the wide path along the stream which then turns into a path and later into a forest road. Shortly after a small bridge, a barely recognizable footpath branches off to the entry.\n\nAlternatively, the route can also be extended by about 30 minutes (canyon) if you first enter at the next bridge (follow the access path for about 7 minutes more).

Tour: (machine translated)

The first small waterfall can be bypassed on the left. A small slide follows, a jump into a large pond and again a slide. The next step is also jumped, climbing up on the right to fly a little longer. The next pools are all downclimbed on the left and a small walking passage follows. After two more jumps and a slide you come to the last steps which are bypassed on the right.

Return: (machine translated)

To the right of the stream, a path leads back to the bridge by the parking lot.


