<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Hiking canyon in alpine surroundings, especially suitable for a tour with children		
<b>Hydrology:</b> (machine translated) In spring during the snowmelt and shortly afterwards kayak river, in midsummer bathing tour, in thunderstorms or heavy rain flash flood danger.		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) Through the Santa Regina canyon on the D84 up the Golo we pass the Calacuccia reservoir and Albertacce. 2km after Albertacce we come to the canyons over the Golo and park our car here for the exit. We take a second car back to Albrtacce and then turn left onto the D318 to Calasima. After a good 2 km, we pass through this village and reach the parking lot at the exit of the paved road (2nd car).		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) About 70m in a south-westerly direction down to the river. If we only have 1 vehicle available, we will walk on the orographic right side. First over the Golo, then basically parallel to U Viru. It is up to us where we want to get in and start the tour.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) We hike down the river on smoothly polished granite, enjoying the ambience, taking the occasional dip, combined with no slides or jumps. The tour can drag on quite a bit. Finally, the Golo flows in from the right through a narrow crevice. A few meters later we get off after the two bridges.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) The car is only a few meters up the road.
