Summary: (machine translated)

At the foot of the Yordas or Burín peak we have this simple but fun canyon if we do it in spring with good flow. Majestic environment by the peaks that surround us, to the south the Gilbo, to the north the Yordas and the exit to the reservoir of Riaño. We can access from the reservoir going up the trail. In summer the stream dries up.

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

From León on the N621 towards Riaño. Once past the bridge we turn left onto the N625 to Cangas de Onís and when we are leaving the reservoir behind, we will find on our left the detour to the CL635 towards Oviedo by the port of Tarna. Soon we will arrive at Burón and a little further on a detour to the left leaves us in Liegos. We cross the village of Liegos and continue along a dirt track in good condition surrounding the Yordas on its west side until a detour with a small track on our left. We park.

Approach: (machine translated)

We follow this new trail towards the pass of Tendeña through a beautiful forest, once at the pass we simply descend along the path next to the river until we see the first difficulties.

Tour: (machine translated)

A first part of skills before the trail crosses the stream. Then a small rappel and again crosses the trail to enter the most sporty part with several rappels with handrails and a slide of almost 30m. Finally an abseil of 7m and a couple of skills before reaching the reservoir.

Return: (machine translated)

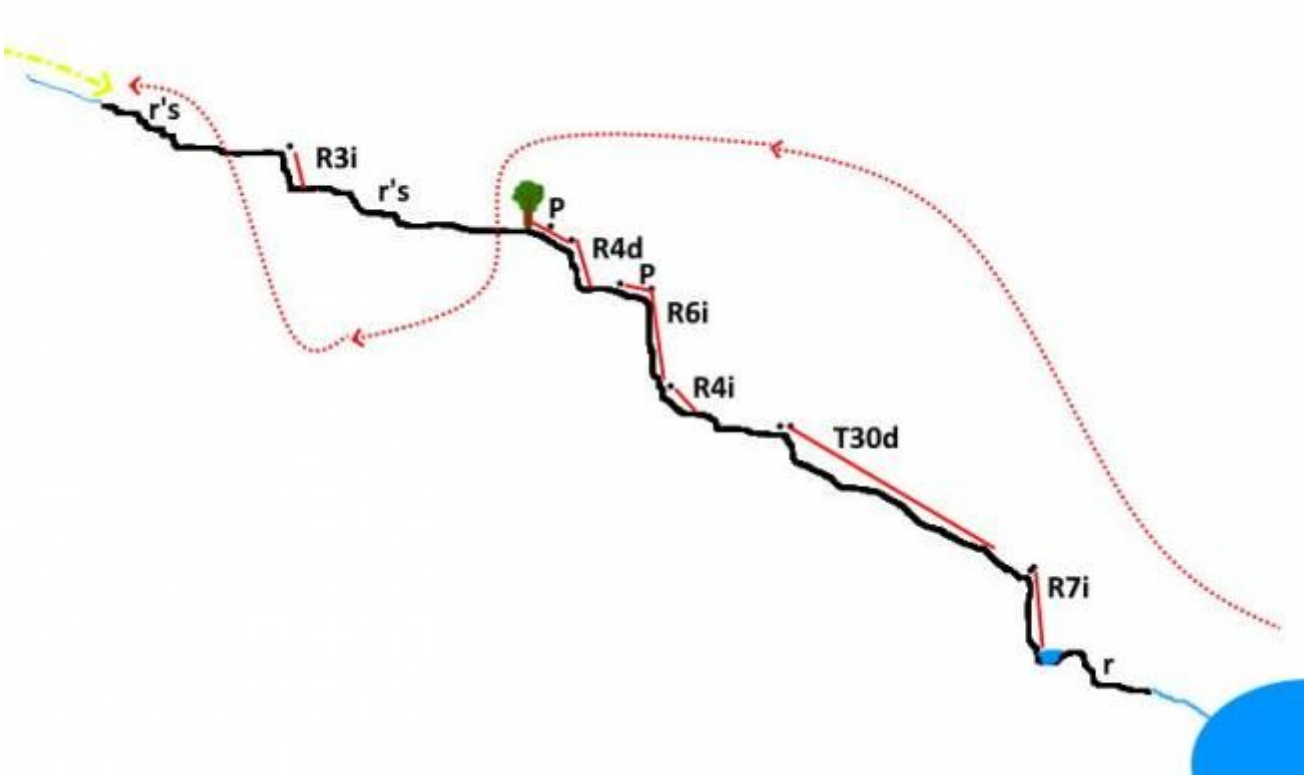
We will leave to the left to take the path that has been crossing the stream until climbing to the pass.
