We must get to Cazorla, from there by the A319 towards Arroyo Frío. We pass the port of Las Palomas and continue. Before arriving at Arroyo Frío, after km 35, there is a bridge over the Guadalquivir and an abandoned hydroelectric plant. Here we park

**Approach:** (machine translated)

Behind the power plant a path climbs next to the river, we go up it until it changes banks. Soon we pass the waterfall of Linarejos with a handrail of chains and soon arriving almost at the base of the reservoir of Cerrada begins the descent.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

A simple descent full of jumps, jumps and rappels where you can practice. Before the 15m rappel we can get out and avoid the second half of the descent that does not have great difficulties but many jumps and pools in which to cool off.
