<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Very beautiful canyon with many successive green pools and several small jumps and slides. Can be superiore combined with the Weissache.		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) From Krumsach along the Brandenberger Ache to the parking lot ( <a href="https://maps.app.goo.gl/WSEoA8iSn9xJMG5R7">https://maps.app.goo.gl/WSEoA8iSn9xJMG5R7</a> ).		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) From the parking lot down to the Brandenberger Ache as far as the bridge (Trauersteg). From here you can follow the Ache upstream either along the gravel road (left) or the hiking trail (right) to the next bridge (at this point the Weißache flows into the Brandenberger Ache). Then follow the forest path upwards (runs parallel to the Weißache into the valley). Always keep left at the junctions. Pass the Weittal hunting lodge until shortly before the Weittalalm. This is the entry point (easy to reach via a small meadow from the forest path).		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) (to be added)...at least 7 abseiling points, not higher than 30m...		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) The Weittalbach flows into the Weißache. Here you can either follow the Weißache to the confluence with the Brandenberger Ache, or get out on the right and follow the forest path back to the parking lot.
