Summary: (machine translated) Rappel canyon in gray limestone with quartz veins, gloomy in places. Extreme risk of falling rocks!		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) We leave the A12 (Sargans-Chur) via the Bad Ragaz exit, drive through the center of Ragaz up to Pfäfers and into the Val Tamina. Passing the reservoir we reach the village of Vättis. Here we turn right and drive westwards into the Calfeisen valley and towards St. Martin to the Gigerwald reservoir. We drive over the top of the dam. From here on, the route is timed, so that one direction can only be taken in a 20-minute time window at a time. Continue along the southern shore of the lake through several tunnels (not suitable for large and wide vehicles!) to a parking lot at the exit of the road, still on the orographic right side of the Tamina reservoir tributary (1470m altitude). Here we park the car.		
Approach: (machine translated) We take the hiking trail away from the parking lot in the direction of the Sardona hut. Immediately we cross "our" stream and can thus judge the water flow. We walk about 300m and come to the foot of a meadow with a large boulder at the edge of the path (see http://www.descente-canyon.com/canyoning/photo/126683/_Quelques-reperes-pour-le-debut-de-la-marche-d-approche#liste) A few meters after this marked boulder we follow a faint track that serpentine up the meadow. About 60m higher, at the eastern edge of the meadow (see red entry in http://www.descente-canyon.com/canyoning/photo/126683/_Quelques-reperes-pour-le-debut-de-la-marche-d-approche#liste), a clearly recognizable path begins, which leads uphill in serpentine through the forest - partly wooden stairs. We follow this until we reach a tree with a sling (currently white Dyneema 5mm rope). Then traverse about 10m via traverse rope into the chute where it now has a ring anchor. From there rappel 50m into the canyon.		
Tour: (machine translated) Caution: A lot of loose debris that can move quickly! A total of 12-15 rappels. 50m to abseil into the canyon. Once in the canyon, we start with a C8, followed by a C35. After a few smaller steps and a passage of walking and climbing down, we come to the narrow and attractive part. After a C19 followed by a C40 and a double step (C36), smaller rappels follow again to the exit of the canyon.		
Return: (machine translated) Descend on the wide gravel bed and out to the right to the parking lot.

Il y a deux entrées : l'une par un étroit couloir, équipée d'une fine corde, mais elle laisse passer deux jolis rappels. L'autre, la plus classique, 80 mètres plus haut. L'arbre avec la corde blanche en Dyneema et la boucle rouge se trouve juste avant une ravine rocheuse. J'ai coupé les branches à 1,5 mètre du bas pour garantir un accès raisonnable à la point de rappel. Dix mètres plus loin, à la même hauteur dans la ravine rocheuse, se trouve un amarrage en acier brillant, qu'il est préférable d'atteindre encordé. Il est déconseillé de s'engager dans cette gorge, en cas de moindre risque de précipitations. Quiconque a déjà fait cette descente, sait exactement pourquoi. Le canyon devient rapidement un piège mortel à cause des chutes de pierres et, par forte pluie, des énormes quantités de débris. Bien qu'il y ait une sortie de secours au début, la gorge se rétrécit considérablement par la suite, et il n'y a aucune issue ! Lors de notre descente d'aujourd'hui, tous les spits étaient présents, même si certains étaient difficiles à trouver et/ou exposés. The anchoring is as expected for such a rarely climbed canyon: single bolts, mostly quite old. Mostly secure, but not every anchor is "good". Mostly very grippy, water very cold. After about 1/3 there is an optional access/exit. Very beautiful, rewarding scenic. Lots of loose rock, extreme risk of falling rocks! (machine translated)
