Summary: (machine translated) Beautiful lime canyon in secluded, scenic surroundings; dark grotto at the end of the tour; emergency exit possibility after the first 35m overhang; Good 10m Inox glued anchors/stances, do not forget light for grotto; Well combinable with Grotta Donini (almost the same way back). Mostly stagnant, deep pools with cold water; stream flows into Rio Flumineddu.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Arbatax continue north (Olbia) on the SS125 to the village of Lozzorei; after the Esso petrol station turn left onto the SP56 (Via Milano); follow the road for a long time; at the fork turn right towards Urzulei; follow the main road (SP37) for approx. 15 km, drive through Urzulei, up the mountain to Urzulei and then turn left onto the SS125 towards Dorgali. Now follow the mountain road until you reach the rock face visible from afar (there is a prominent building on the right) - turn left here. Follow the asphalt road for about 1 km (under the striking rock face around the mountain), then the road becomes an off-road track for 21 km (you are on a plateau) - from here it is about 40 minutes (to the parking entry). Keep right at the first junction and keep left at the fork with signs (spray-painted lettering). After the fork, the road descends, and after two prominent bends you drive over a crossing (dried-up streambed). After the crossing, follow the main course of the road through the wooded area (past a house with the sign "Grotta Donini/Orbisi") for a long time until the exit of the paved road where there is a turnaround area with 2 trees in the middle. Park here (780m).		
Approach: (machine translated) From the parking lot/turnaround a little uphill on the right, past the fenced property with a striking round building with a wooden roof. Descend here to the Cordula Orbisi stream, which you reach shortly (750m).		

Tour: (machine translated)

Once in the dry streambed, follow it for about 10 minutes without any great difference in altitude until you reach the first abseiling point of about 4m (hourglass on the right). Info: On the way to the first descent point, you pass the small entrance hole of the Grotta Donini. From here the canyon narrows. There are 2 more rappels in pools before the overhanging 35m rappel. A removable rope traverse should be set up to reach the belay safely. Here you will often be watched by curious tourists descending over the ridge into the canyon (possible emergency exit on the left). After a short open walking passages/block terrain, there is a step that is downclimbed. Here the canyon narrows again. Then comes a short step, followed by two 20m abseils. Between the abseils, you have to climb up from a crevasse using a helpful fixed rope with foot slings (not easy). After this point there is a short swimming passage that leads into the dark part of the canyon (grotto), in the grotto (darkness) there is a short swimming passage and two abseiling points of 11m and 17m. Alternative: According to the topographic view, you can bypass the grotto with 2 abseiling points (12 and 35m) (not used). You will soon have daylight again and stand in front of a large rock hole from which you can rappel the last 17m into the open. After this point, you can exit immediately to the left over the steep rocks at approx. 540m (you save yourself the last rather unspectacular steps and ascent time). A little tip: if you climb over the rocks on the right, first a little up and then down, you will be at the exit/final waterfall of Grotta Donini.

Return: (machine translated)

From the 540m point, turn left up steep, easy-to-climb rocks (cairn markings). Follow the gravel field reached after a short time to the right, slightly uphill (cairn) to the open ridge. Then follow the ridge and the path, which is now becoming increasingly visible, uphill. After about 20 minutes you reach the gravel road which you follow past a fountain/watering trough to the starting point/parking lot.
