Summary: (machine translated) Long and alpine canyon with long access. Has lost much of its former attractiveness after a mudslide.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Solenzara on the N 198 (Bastia - Porto Vecchio) on the winding D268 west towards Bavella. After 10 km the road crosses the river Solenzara and after a total of 11.7 km the Fiumicelli, the orographic left tributary of the Solenzara. We cross the bridge and continue on the road for 2.2 km to a ruined house on the right side of the road. Here we park the car.		
Approach: (machine translated) Here we turn right from the tarred road onto a hiking trail (towards Bocca di Saltu), which first leads us in about 20 min. down to the Fiumicelli stream bed (290m alt.). We cross it and take the path beyond that leads up to Bocca di Saltu (871m old.) We now follow the track uphill, but after 2 switchbacks and a right-left bend we turn left onto a path that leads us up to the ridge. We reach it near a concrete water tank (1058m old.). Now we follow the path that always goes up on the ridge. Finally we come to the chapel of Tova. Continuing in the previous direction we go down to the spring of Tova. Here begins the descent.		
Tour: (machine translated) The original route descriptions are largely outdated by the 2010 mudslide. Only the high rapel still shows in its original form. The somewhat tricky Marmita Trampa was filled by the mudflow.		
Return: (machine translated) Where we crossed the Fiumicelli in the access, we now exit on the path to the right and thus reach the car.
