Summary: (machine translated) Garbage dump, a high rappel, possibly slide Rwei		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Flows at first, but then dries out quickly at the level of the C75.		
Access: (machine translated) From Nice, leave Arma di Taggia and follow the SS 548 through the Argentina Valley to Molini di Triora. Continue on the SP52 to Triora and then to Loreto. Continue towards Réaldo on the SP81, pass Creppo and, 3 km further on, look out for the San Antonio waterfall on the left. Park just after the bridge over the Rio di Barbone, at the level of the "Mulino centro d'arte" signs.		
Approach: (machine translated) Follow the direction "Realdo-Ponte Romano". Cross the Argentina on an old bridge and climb up to the village of Realdo opposite. Cross the village through the alleyways and cross to the other side to Rio San Antonio.		
Tour: (machine translated) This canyon is the garbage dump of the village above. It should therefore be avoided unless you are writing a doctoral thesis on the decomposition of waste. A relay station on the right bank divides the large waterfall into C25 + C50. The most interesting part of the route is at the exit, when you cross the Argentina: two nice tobogganing routes seem feasible.		
Return: (machine translated) After crossing the Argentina (check the current at the bridge during the approach), go straight on to the road and then left to the car.
