Summary: (machine translated) Forest canyon, in between attractive abseiling sequence.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) Leave the freeway A93 (Rosenheim - Kufstein) at the exit Oberaudorf and drive in eastern direction on the federal road 172 for about 12 km to Walchsee/Tyrol. In the village Walchsee turn left in front of the hotel "Das Walchsee" into the Hausbergstraße. The road leads in the direction of Winkl. At a fork in the road (a sign points to the left "Winkl") keep right and continue straight ahead to the parking lot at the sports field (daily fee 3 Euro - 2023).		
Approach: (machine translated) From the parking lot at the sports field we follow the road further through the houses of Oberwinkl and cross the Ramsbach. About 100 meters further we keep left at the junction and come to the bridge over the Kohlenrieder Bach. In front of the bridge - following the heaped signposts - among others "Wasserfall" - turn right and follow the path along the brook upwards. The path goes steeply up in serpentine and after about 40 min. (keeping left at the signposted turn-off to the Angeringalm) we come to the wooden footbridge over "our" brook. We look at the Lochner waterfall, which marks the exit of the upper part of the gorge climb. Continue up through the forest until we meet a forest road, which we follow to the right. We cut off a serpentine of the forest road, when we reach the track again we follow it to the right until it ends. Here we descend to the stream, rappel the last meters from the tree if necessary.		
Tour: (machine translated) The upper part is not unattractive, especially the 32 m rappel. The lower part (from the wooden footbridge) is a forest canyon with downclimbs and many smaller rappels (max. about 25 m). The belaying is of inconsistent quality. Several times there are optimal chain anchors (where they would not necessarily be expected), but on the 32 m rappel, where one would wish for such a chain anchor, there are only 3 isolated anchors, one of which is a glued anchor. At the high rappel, after about 25 meters you come to a small swimming pool, where you will find a usable anchor for a transfer on the "outer wall" on the left above. The stream should also be run commercially.		

Return: (machine translated)

Either after the Lochner waterfall out onto the wooden footbridge and down the ascent path again or - after walking the lower part - about 760 m above sea level on a relatively clear exit track left out onto the access path and this back to the parking lot.

More water than normal, but doable after the rain yesterday. On the 12m rappel before the 35m waterfall, be careful when pulling off the rope, it can easily get caught in the tree. Otherwise ok so far. (machine translated)

Fixed ropes replaced, anchors ok. Blockage in walking passages. The crux after the 20 has no more wood. However, this is now directly on the edge of the 35 rappel. So it is ok but after the next high water it will be exciting. There is also a large tree trunk in the small intermediate pool at the 35. Not really disturbing but can be problematic for pulling off the rope. (machine translated)

Everything was fine up to the crux, sometimes very slippery. In the hole after the 20m rappel large tree trunks inside, a step to leave the hole completely bent. Then on the following 12m rappel there is a large tree directly in the rappel line. With a bit of skill you can get through. I try to free the spot from the bakm as quickly as possible. From the 35m rappel it's ok again... (machine translated)

Great conditions, stands ok. Some fixed ropes renewed. (machine translated)

In winter, in ice and snow, walk from halfway up to the bridge. Pay close attention to falling ice and avalanches. In fresh snow, this can lead to dangerous situations, especially in the upper section. Stands and fixed ropes were all in order (machine translated)

Everything ok, partly dead wood but not disturbing. Not as slippery as usual. Only the upper part up to the wooden bridge. (machine translated)

Perfect water level, upper part up to the wooden bridge. Slightly better set up to climb out better after the 20 rappel into the hole. Left in the basin steps mounted and new fixed ropes. Very slippery. New chain anchor at the 35er left! Replaced some fixed ropes. (machine translated)

Upper part up to the wooden bridge. Stands all ok! Top conditions! Very slippery! From time to time there is dead wood in the stream but never disturbing only during walking passages. (machine translated)

Small season start and all stands checked, everything in order! Very slippery! Nice upper part, still wood in the lower part, but you can get through! (machine translated)

You can still climb about 10min further up at the last junction from the forest road follow the path towards Burgeralm, then enter where you come directly to the stream. Small slides and waterfalls alternate until the waterfalls become higher. Everything is well set up. New belaystation at the high waterfall. In the lower part after the last high rappel still some wood (remains of avalanche) but you get through well! Nice tour with cool fun part in the upper part then beautiful rappels! Additional info: Parking fee now € 3 and the hotel in the description is no longer called Schick but Hotel Das Walchsee! (machine translated)
