Access:

Park the first car at Termine di Cadore if you also plan to descend the Lutrignon stream and across Piave (10 minutes from Lutrignon end).

Park at Davesira if you exit from the gorge on path 392 just before start descent of Lutrignon (60 minutes).

Approach:

Park upper car at Casera di Conte in the Zemola Valley and follow signs for Forcella di Zita. From there, descend along the CAI391 trail to an elevation of 1,750 meters to begin the long descent.
