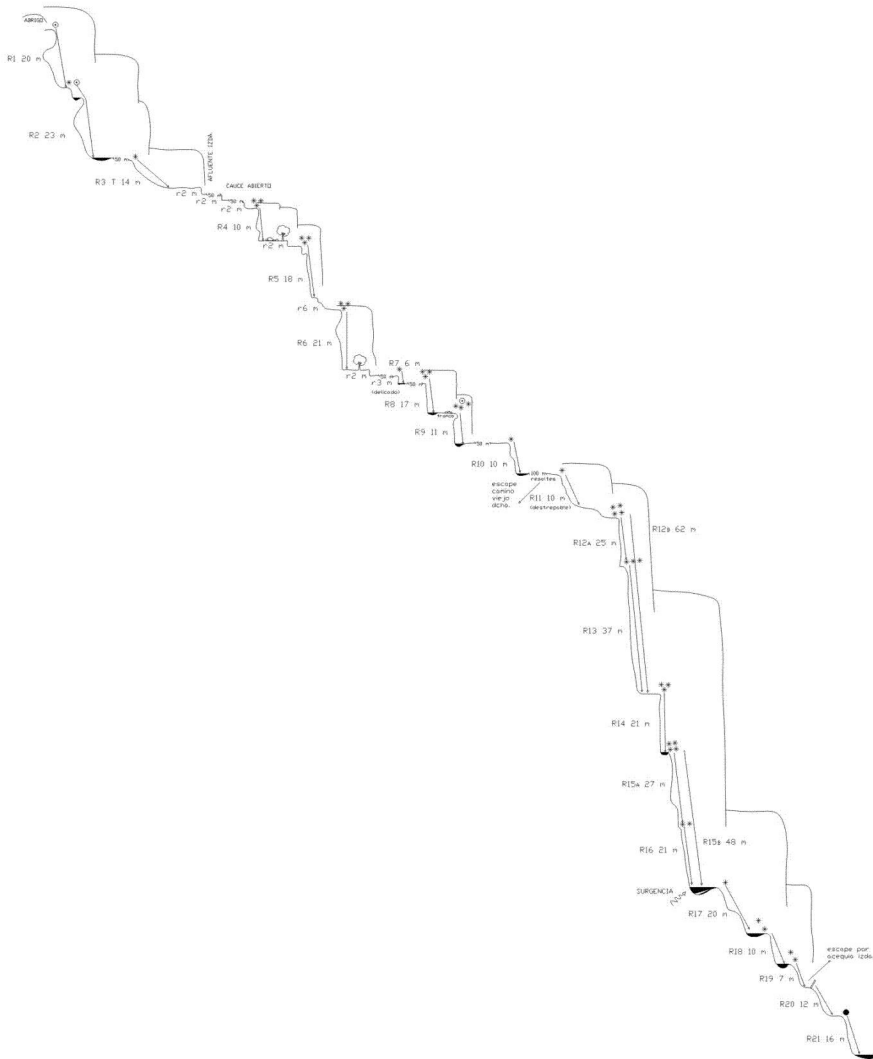

Summary: (machine translated) Very vertical canyon and almost always dry except for the final stretch. If it is done in autumn or spring it can carry water, which enhances the experience. Ask the board for permission to do it.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) We must reach the town of Santiago de la Espada on the A317. We continue towards the source of the Segura River. At km49 there is a road on the right towards La Toba. We continue along this road and after almost 2kms, before a wide curve to the left there is a track on the right which we follow for about 4km and we arrive at the parking lot at the head of the road. If we continue along the road and make the bend, we will find some very sharp curves after which we will be above the Segura. In a bridge that crosses the Arroyo Aguas Buitre we park the car to return.		
Approach: (machine translated) Very fast, just follow the north direction and go down the riverbed to the first rapel.		
Tour: (machine translated) Normally dry, the descent is quite technical due to its two 60m waterfalls that are split.		
Return: (machine translated) Immediate if we take two cars. If not, we have to go back to the head car.
