Summary: (machine translated) Granite canyon; some overhanging sections directly in the watercourse; rope retrieval often difficult; some slippery sections; water partly cloudy; final rappel section is divided into 20m/45m/53m with good belays; Inox glued anchors and belays Exposure: East Tip: In our opinion, the most interesting part of the canyon is from the bridge to after the high rappel. You don't need a shuttle car for this part. If you want to do the whole tour, leave a shuttle car in the parking lot described above and take a second car up the 4.5 km Ricahtung Arzana on the SP27. The entrance to the upper entry is on the left directly on the SP27 at a house with a stone wall as a fence and some electric poles. Here you could drive down the gravel road a bit to find a possible parking lot. You should plan about 3-4 hours for the whole tour.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Arbatax head west on the SS198; after 2.1km turn right onto the SP27; after approx. 15 minutes (13.8km) you will see a gravel road on the right with a cross (motorcycle accident) in front of it and a wooden sign with the name "Cascata Sotzai". Turn right here and follow the gravel road for approx. 200m until you reach a house. Park here.		
Approach: (machine translated) To get to the entry point of the tour, walk along the gravel road back out to the SP27 and follow it for about 6 minutes to the bridge that crosses the Bau Figu. Descend through the gardens or directly from the bridge or left.		
Tour: (machine translated) Directly after the bridge there is a short walk and downclimb to the first 20m rappel. This is also the most difficult of the tour because you rappel directly in the water and overhanging into a deep pool. The section is also very slippery. There is the possibility of setting up a ropeway, glued anchors on the edge of the gully or left. The next 4 shorter abseils are not long in coming, max. 10m. The last of the short rappels can cause difficulties during rope retrieval (clamping block). A short walk and downclimb follows before you have a beautiful view of the valley (reservoir). Here you are already at the final cascade. First abseil 20m to the belay station of the 45m rappel, followed by the highest rappel at 53m. There is enough space between the 45m and 53m rappels to stand unsecured. The water is spread over a large area across the broad rocky ridge. After the high cascade, it is not worth continuing the tour, as there is only a long river walk and a 20m rappel to come.		
Return: (machine translated) Directly after the high final abseil or to the right, follow the clearly visible hiking trail along the wooden railing steeply uphill to the parking lot.
