Summary: (machine translated) Hiking canyon with dark gorge and rappel(s), usually vigorous water flow.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Bad Tölz via Lenggries to the Sylvensteinsee. There turn left and 5.6 km on the B 307 in the direction of Achensee. Immediately after the road bridge over the Walchen (Achenbach) park the vehicle on the right. Alternatively, access from Achensee on the B 181 in the direction of Lenggries (17.4 km from Camping Achensee).		
Approach: (machine translated) From the parking lot take the forest road, which runs in a westerly direction towards the Hühnerbach. Then high above the Hühnerbach in a southerly direction. At just over 900 m above sea level, a grassy slope leads down to the right almost to the stream (entry).		
Tour: (machine translated) After a short stretch in the open streambed, you come to the first steps and the short but attractive dark gorge (2009 fixed ropes). After the dark gorge, you can exit to the right up to the approach trail. The canyon is now relatively open and presents itself - except for another rappel - as a hiking canyon. Finally, the Hühnerbach flows into the Walchen, which you swim through to the far bank. It is recommended to approach the Hühnerbach via the Pitzbach (see there).		
Return: (machine translated) Once you reach the north bank of the Walchen, turn east and after a few minutes you will meet the main road and return on it to the parking lot.

Automatisch importiert von Descente-Canyon.com für Canyon Hühnerbach At the beginning of the canyon (at the end of Pitzbach), you will go a few hundred meters in/ round the river and next, there are 2/3 small jumps/toboggans and when the walls of the canyon are going closer, there is a 4/5 m high rappel. On the walls of the canyon are a lot of bolts, but all of them are removed (by flex, the rock is also damaged here. 2 of them are damaged by water). It's not possible to go further - we did not try it, so I do not know if there are any bolts on the next rappel. When I walked the Hühnerbach in July 2023, all the hooks from the Dunkelklamm had been knocked out or the chain links had been unscrewed. So you should take a few chain links with nuts with you. At 2 abseiling points it is better to abseil first and check whether the water depth is sufficient for a jump. The exit before the Walchen on the right was still well equipped. (machine translated)
