<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Forest canyon, divided into two parts apart, with smaller rappels and fun potential.		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) We leave the A5 (Yverdon - Neuchâtel) via the exit Yverdon-Ouvest ud take the road to Sainte Croic in direction NW. After about 6 km we reach the village of Vuiteboeuf and park our car at the northern exit of the village near the bridge over the Arnon (see approach in photo gallery).		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) Before the road bridge over the Arnon, we turn left onto the hiking trail towards Sainte Croix. After a good half hour, this crosses the river. After that we look for an entry point into the river.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) The first part offers some smaller rappels. At the end of the short gorge, it is best to take the access path back and then climb right before the beginning of the second and more interesting section of the gorge. Here are some jumps and slides.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) Where the canyon ends, right up the trail and out to the car.
