From Kathmandu on the Prithvi Hwy westwards towards Pokhara. After 130 km in 4 hours - if it walks well - we come to Dumre. You can also get here from Pokhara after 67 km in a good 2 hours. In Dumre we turn northwards into the valley of the river Marsyangdi and reach Besisahar after 42 km and 1,5 hours. Here the paved road ends (2011). Now on dirt road 24 km or 75 min. further to the village of Syange. This is also the approach if you approach the Annapurna Trek from the east, i.e. counterclockwise. Here or in the vicinity (e.g. in Germu on the other side of the river) we will take up quarters for the ascent of the surrounding canyons. \From Syange we go downstream in the direction of Besisahar. After about 5 km we reach the starting point for the access from the north side. Here the trail leads towards the hamlet of Sildhunga (1460m altitude). About 300m further we cross "our" stream, again 1 km further is the starting point for the direct access via the orographic right side of the starting point for the access to Dod Kabindra Khola.
