Hardly used, steep tour with pathless access that leads directly into the Erlauf with a 55m waterfall. The Erlauf has to be swum through after the tour.

### Hydrology:

#### Access:

From Kienberg up into the Erlauftal valley to the Eibenboden parking lot.

#### Approach:

(machine translated)  
Briefly return along the road and cross the bridge in the direction of Nestelberg. After the bridge over the stream, turn right uphill on the Kassteig until a frost road leads to the left just before the meadows of the Gnadenberger. Follow this forest road in the direction of the ditch, descending into the Grabengrund without a path.

Abseiling sequence:

4m rappel from tree

150m walk

Then you are already in front of the big waterfall.
