Good flow. All anchors are in place and in very good condition. Cool and interesting sections. After the last rappels (red rock), about 150 m downstream, you can easily exit the canyon on the right side via a path (forest road). The path leads to the road, from which you can quickly reach the parking lot. (machine translated)

The anchors are new, thank you, it's a pleasure. As I said, there are a lot of trees, but they're not too much of a hindrance to progress. We found a very comfortable exit on the right bank through the pastures, to confirm if it's a good idea or not. We also found a rope -> private message to retrieve it (machine translated)
