Parking at the top, on the GC291, at km 6 at the height of Cenobio or a little further on just where the rappels are.

If we want to park at the bottom we will go to San Felipe by the GC751 until the end.

From the top it is very simple, we have the rings under the guardrail of the road.

From below by the street Diseminado de San Felipe we approach the base of the highway bridge, arriving we will find a path on the right "Camino de San Felipe" where we will go up until we reach the height of the highway, we leave the path and go left towards the Cenobio.
