At the first high rappel there is an intermediate belay after three meters on the right, but it is difficult to reach. On the second high waterfall, it's better to take the belay on the right of the edge (old fixed ropes) than the dizzy anchor on the left. Overall, it is easier with 2x40m (machine translated)
