Summary: (machine translated) rappel canyon		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Nassereith, south of the Fernpass after the tunnel drive in the direction of Innsbruck. The hairpin bends up to Holzleiten (8.5 km from the tunnel). Here turn off the main road 189,, through Holzleiten northwards to Weisland and further in the direction of Aschland. Between both villages the road crosses the brook. Park approx. 50 m before the bridge on the right side of the road.		
Approach: (machine translated) From the parking lot (1150 m a.s.l.) a forest road leads to the Marienbergalm. At the first junction (1410 m a.s.l.) follow the right flat or gently sloping forest road to the Holzerhütte (1390 m a.s.l.).		
Tour: (machine translated) Many smaller rappels, downclimbs, no jumps or slides		
Return: (machine translated) After the last zig-zag rappel, which can be bypassed on the left by a small slip, turn right beyond clear tracks onto a small path that leads down to the forest road and the car.

On access via the forest road, the entry was easy to find if you keep right at the first junction behind the cow gate. The holds were all good, some new chain anchors were drilled in. Only at abseil point no. 4 was the anchor difficult to reach. Otherwise a beautiful canyon with lots of downclimbing and a few nice rappels. (machine translated)
