| Summary: (machine translated) Three narrow gorge passages with walking terrain in between. At the beginning of this millennium, a huge avalanche went down over the ditch, burying it deep. Slowly, the stream uncovers the gorges again. | | |
| Hydrology: | | |
| Access: (machine translated) On the A9 to exit Hinterstoder, to Hinterstoder, through the village to a large parking lot on the right side (parking lot Schiederweiher) for a fee. | | |
| Approach: (machine translated) Follow the signs in the direction of Prielschutzhaus. After about 30min you reach the GH Polsterstüberl (up to here also bicycle possible). Then on forest road with driving ban further into the valley bottom, and over a steep, stony hiking trail to under a striking waterfall. Here into the gravelly streambed and steeply downhill to a mouth of another ditch from the right. Here is the entrance. Possibly you can also start the gorge from higher up (but then take more ropes and drill). | | |
| Tour: (machine translated) from Sauschwanz left rappel 10m, then 5m orogr. right downclimb (flattened glued anchor right), from left rappel 20m over two pools, then 6m from Sauschwanz right and 25m from anchor right. Exit of the first gorge section. 100m downclimb through the large blocky streambed (escape on the left), the second gorge starts with two slides/downclimb before rappelling from anchor on the right into a nice gorge section. Downclimb 2x5m, then a short rappel until a 10m rappel into a nice but unfortunately too shallow basin leads out of the second gorge. Again downclimb 200m before the third and last gorge begins at an escape possibility on the left. Carefully downclimb into the gorge (glued anchor high up on the left), the last two meters you can jump (be sure to check the pool first). Here rappel twice more (5m, 10m) before the gorge ends. The last Sauschwanz is in great need of improvement. | | |

Gorge unfortunately almost dry. With each flood, the formerly completely filled gorge is cleared again and is slowly worthwhile again. More water would have been nice. In the first gorge passage, two glue hooks were completely flattened, here we have set new 8mm drill hooks. (machine translated)
