<b>Summary:</b> (machine translated) Natural ravine to descend the waterfall of La Cervigona. Long approach and ravine without great charm except for the waterfall. Protected species of interest nesting in the same waterfall, so from February 15 to July 15 it is forbidden to make the descent (Annex II Master Plan of the Natura Network in Extremadura).		
<b>Hydrology:</b>		
<b>Access:</b> (machine translated) We must go to Acebo in the Sierra de Gata, Cáceres. Once there we cross the village and at the next detour we turn left towards the dam. We will follow the road, which then becomes a track to the dam.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) From the dam we follow the path of the old hydroelectric plant, here we will see the old pipe that fell from the top of the mountain, we will ascend along its side and when we reach the top we turn left following the channel. Soon we will find a path that takes us down to the stream.		
<b>Tour:</b> (machine translated) Descent in which the most remarkable feature is the Cervigona waterfall.		
<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) A path on the left hand side with milestones will lead us to the hydroelectric power plant on the way up.
