Summary: (machine translated) Rappel canyon without running routes, long straight slide as a highlight (covered with gravel in 2024)		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) Attention! People often steal in the parking lot. Do not leave any valuables in the car.		
Approach: (machine translated) From the parking lot, follow trail no. 505 (keep right, otherwise take the via ferrata). Follow the path steeply upwards, secured by a steel cable, with easy climbing sections that are not difficult, up the slope until you reach the gulch. Continue a few more meters until you reach the stream. (Theoretically, you can continue up the via ferrata to get a little higher)		
Tour: (machine translated) To reach the first belay, a rope traverse can be set up (either from the gear hooks on the ladder or from an anchor a little further ahead). After reaching the first belay, rappel after rappel without any significant running distances. The description in the AIC booklet from 2024 mentions a slide - however, all pools are currently covered with gravel.		
Return: (machine translated) From the basin of the last rappel, ladders of the via ferrata go steeply upwards. Do not follow these, but follow the steel cable and the clear path on the righthand side. After a few meters, cross the stream over a small bridge and continue along the path until you reach the car.
