Summary: (machine translated) Narrow dark subglacial rather vertical canyon with southern orientation.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Season October - November, before the visit it must be dry for a week and the 0°C isotherm below 2800m must have existed for more than 24 hours.		
Access: (machine translated) Flem-Express from Flims to Segnes or Fil da Cassons. Alternatively, take the Postbus from Laax-Bergbahn to Alp-Nagens. October 2025 "the ideal canyoning season seems to fall in the off-season, when there are no cable cars or post buses running to Nagens/Segnes. The chairlift to Naraus don't exist anymore. I have checked with the relevant municipality to see whether driving permits for the road to Nagens can be issued/purchased. However, they have informed me that these are only issued for agricultural purposes. This means that from 19 October, Nagens can only be reached on foot or by mountain bike or maybe e-bike."		
Approach: (machine translated) 45min from Fil da Cassons (300m descent to the valley), 1h from Segnes, 1h15 from Nagens (400m ascent to the mountain).

Commitment

Alternative route at the exit of the plateau in front of the second ropes course with climbing rd; in front of the large waterfalls (access via a path above the cliff) if a rope is installed.

Period/ water character

Subglacial, glacier with southern orientation.

Season October - November, before the visit it must be dry for a week and the 0°C isotherm below 2800m must have existed for more than 24 hours.

Remarks

A canister that is too wide in the rucksack can block it. Headlamp useful for additional visibility, but not necessary.

On the C10 after the C25 in the 2nd part (Swiss Alps topographic view) there was a fatal accident in 2024 due to a trapped foot. A slot covered by water can become a deadly trap here.

On 19.10.2025, the spot was defused by an orographic new anchor on the left side, the anchor on the right is currently still there! The plate should be removed here when the opportunity arises, but the bolt and nut should be retained. See also picture in the gallery.

Return: (machine translated)

approx. 15 minutes along the Segnesboden (following the water) to the Segnes cable car station. Options from there down to Flims:

- Cable car Flem-Express
- approx. 45min to the Alp-Nagens bus station
- approx. 1h to Naraus (dismantled cable car station)
- Hiking trail down to Startgels (approx. 1h), possibly to Flims (approx. 2 to 3 hours)

Lots of water as early as 7:30 in the morning. All the mountains in the area, even above the Segnes and the upper Segnesboden were covered in snow. Instead of the clouds expected according to the weather forecast, there was a fantastic sunrise. A few meters after the entry we decided to abort for safety's sake, the risk of rising water levels due to melting snow was too high for us. We went down to the emergency exit, where the long ropes had been deposited, and climbed back up there to the final waterfalls. The residual water volume according to flims Elektrik of <70l seems unrealistic or not meaningful to us, we also had this impression 2 days earlier in the Flem Video: <https://youtu.be/htfl37QieTc> (machine translated)
