#### **Summary:** (machine translated)

Open, south-facing canyon that flows into the Seibertsgraben. Hiking routes alternate with smaller rappels. Some possible jumps.

## Hydrology:

### Access: (machine translated)

Coming from Bad Tölz we drive on the B 13, past Lenggries, to the Sylvenstein reservoir (21.5 km). Arrived on the dam crest we keep right on the B 307 in the direction of Fall, Vorderriß. After not quite 6 km (from Dammkrone) we turn right from the B 307 onto a gravel road and park our car in front of the barrier.

#### **Approach:** (machine translated)

We continue along the track and cross the Isar on or next to a dam. About 300m further on, the track bends to the right. At the exit of the right-hand bend, we turn left onto a slope that leads north. 70m further on, we also turn right off this track and take the forest path, which initially leads us steeply uphill in a northerly direction. About 500m after it begins, the path turns left and after another 200m we come to the Staffelgraben (this path - from Isar - can be easily traced on the "Bayernatlas" (tick "Wanderwege" in the menu, then marked in orange): http://geoportal.bayern.de/bayernatlas/?X=5269874.36&Y=4461781.60&zoom=11&lang=de&topic=ba&bgLayer=atkis&callayers=e528a2a8-44e7-46e9-9069-1a8295b113b5 . Now cross the Staffelgraben, then keep left of the Seibertsgraben flowing towards us (i.e. orographic right of it) up the steep slope and at an altitude of 930 m we come to a transverse and horizontal forest road. Up to here the same access as to Staffelgraben. Now take the forest road to the right in the direction of Jachenau, Höfen. The slope approaches the Seibertsgraben. Where it crosses it, we can easily get in without disturbing the marshy meadows.\nAccess is also possible where the forest road comes close to the stream for the first time. The cascades begin here immediately.

#### **Tour:** (machine translated)

Alternate between walking, downclimbing and rappel. Some possible jumps. Nothing changes once you reach the Seibertsgraben.

## **Return:** (machine translated)

A few meters before the Seibertsgraben flows into the Staffelgraben, turn right, cross the Staffelgraben and follow the approach path back to the car.
