Summary: (machine translated) Rain stream. Sequence of rappels in vegetation Emergency exit possible at any time.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) From Bellinzona, take the country road on the right bank of the Ticino towards Tenero and Locarno. Cross the village of Sementina and approx. 3 km after Sementina turn off the main road to the right into the village of Gudo. Park on the right-hand side of the road 300 m after the turn-off from the main road.		
Approach: (machine translated) From the parking lot, follow the road up to the right in front of the church and follow the path until you reach the road. Continue to the right here. After approx. 100 m, follow the path uphill to the left until you reach the road again. Continue to the left until you reach the stream.		
Tour: (machine translated) Absolutely rainy tour, almost always possible, whether heavy rain or melting snow. Sequence of rappels up to max. 30 m. Some of the stands were a bit wobbly (as of 2021) and some of the trees with slings were questionable. Not recommended after periods of drought.		
Return: (machine translated) Turn left out of the stream back to the car.

For this reason, and because the pick has been removed from the last C30 (anchoring to a tree is possible), we left the route after the C8RD. A clearly visible path leads directly to the ascent route. (machine translated)

The stream was a good alternative after rain and more rain was forecast. The water level was slightly higher than the higher reference pictures from "Eldorado Ticino". At the first rappel at the bridge we attached an additional rope. IMPORTANT: the last 30 (penultimate rappel) no longer has an anchor. We then went out. The tree may also be orthographic. Right. The left tree is unsuitable. (machine translated)
