Summary: (machine translated) A rappel chain with 5 rappels.		
Hydrology: (machine translated) Carry out in spring or after rainfall. Dry in summer.		
Access: (machine translated) If you are coming to Peyraud from the north, turn right at the traffic circle to pass the bakery. Turn left into Rue du Pont Romain. Cross the bridge and turn right into the road that runs along the right bank of the Crémieux stream. It quickly turns into a dirt road; park there without obstructing traffic (path to exit the vehicle). Good parking facilities.		
Approach: (machine translated) Haipin bends along the same path. Cross the Roman bridge again to get to the left bank of the river and walk up the road past the cemetery. Continue straight ahead along the footpath that starts between the red barriers. Continue for about 30 m and leave the marked path at the bend to the right to take a very good path on the left that runs alongside a fence. The path soon overlooks the stream. A flat or even slightly sloping part precedes a small steep climb that begins shortly after a prominent large boulder on your left (a kind of boulder measuring 4 m x 3 m). Climb up the steep part; when the path flattens out and enters a wooded area again, continue for about 40 m until you find the start of a path I made ;) that starts on your left (remains of a cairn 5 m left on a boulder). There are other ways up, but this one is by far the quickest and saves you tedious wading through the river.		
Tour: (machine translated) A rappel chain with 5 rappels. Equipped with single-point anchors + carabiners		
Return: (machine translated) After the last waterfall, take the path up to the right. Follow it straight ahead. It leads to a well-maintained path that leads to your vehicle.
