On the day that we went it was quite windy and cloudy so it was colder in the canyon but perfect walking back. Bring water and sunscreen with you!!!! We had an offline wikitrail GPS map to find the exit and it was tricky nonetheless since right now the only two cairns (Steinmännchen) are on the wrong path!! The actual path ist 20m further down on the right. The second half of the path is marked with white spray paint so it's easy to follow. It took us 5 and a half hours with lots of picture time and 15min way finding ????? The highest rappel is less than 20m (I could equip it with a 38m rope and there still was some left) have fun!! It has to be said that you have to climb a lot here and there are several places where there are larger drops without protection and you are also very exposed to the wind.
