Coming from Bad Tölz we drive on the B13, past Lenggries, in the direction of Sylvensteinspeicher. Directly after the commercial area and 3.1 km after the exit into the center of Lenggries, we turn left from the B13 and drive to the village of Jachenau (15.5 km from B 13). We park the car in the large parking lot at the Schützenhaus Jachenau, northeast of the church.

Approach: (machine translated)

At the parking lot we take the footbridge over the Kleine Laine and follow the hiking trail (red dot) to the waterfall and further in the direction of Rappinschlucht/Rappinalm. It leads near the Große Laine, first in the forest, up the valley, crosses it after about 40 min. and meets a forest road a little later. We follow this road for 900 m until we see a footbridge over the brook on the left hand side near a shrine at the roadside (for directions see also "Wasserfallweg": http://www.jachenau.de/wasserfall-weg). On the path we cross to the other side of the stream, walk along the Rappinlaine and then climb up until we can descend to the left across a meadow to the Rappinlaine (entry).

Tour: (machine translated)

We pass a few pools before the stream narrows and the rappel begins. Jumps are also possible here - after prior testing. Where the canyon opens, you first climb down a few more steps and then walk in the streambed or on the ascent path, as soon as it is possible to get off on it, back to the footbridge and the forest road.

Return: (machine translated)

On the approach path back to the car.

Alternatively, you can continue the tour in Staffelbach and/or Glasbach (see there!).
