Summary: (machine translated)

Tajo (= cut), a "city canyon", i.e. a canyon through the middle of the city of Ronda. The canyon opens up after a high bridge construction (Puente Nuevo).

Hydrology:

Access: (machine translated)

We drive to the town of Ronda in the province of Malaga, take the Carretera (Ctra) de los Molinos down to the Albergue Los Molinos and park the car about 100m before reaching the hotel.

If we want to make a transfer, the second car is parked at "CocheCab2" near the Baños Árabes.

Approach: (machine translated)

From the CocheCab2, continue along the Cajé Molino de Alacron and cross the Puente (bridge) de las Curtidurias. We continue and pass some houses on the right of the road. Immediately after this row of houses, turn right and follow the path that leads down to the Guadelevín (entry). You can also park at the exit of this row of houses on the left-hand side of the road.

If we only have one vehicle and have parked it at the Albergue Los Molinos, we take the footpath up to the town, cross it and come to the entry via the Puente de las Curtidurias as described above - see the blue route in google maps in the photos.

Tour: (machine translated)

First under 2 bridges, then we wade through the Tajo (slit). After the Puente Nuevo the rappel follows. See photos and video.

Return: (machine translated)

About 150m after the 4th and last rappel (24m) we look for an indistinct track that leads left out of the river and up to Albergue Los Molinos and the car.

Access closed due to building of a new walkway through the canyon. Looks like soon the canyon will have tourists going through it and looking on the canyoneers from above. Alternatively, and actually fairly attractive, is the via ferrata Tajo I (and II which is apparently closed but can be done descending in a loop). Water quality obviously very questionable.
