Summary: (machine translated) Short but attractive canyon because of its narrowness and relatively high water flow.				
Hydrology:				
Access: (machine translated) From St. Johann/Tyrol 7 km north on the 312 to Erpfendorf. Turn left there and continue for 2 km to Wohlmating. Turn left before the bridge over the Taxabach, then right over the small bridge, immediately left again, keeping left again at the farm and up to the start of the ascent. Park your car here on the right. Coming from Kössen (Upper Bavaria) in the direction of St. Johann, you will reach Wohlmating after 12 km.				
Approach: (machine translated) Either on the forest road or better on an inconspicuous path on the orographic left side of the stream, then left over the wooden bridge - with informative view into the canyons - and after another 50m right down into the streambed above the bedload barrier.				
Tour: (machine translated) A tyrolienne is temporarily installed on the 1st rappel C22. But 2x30m ropes are necessary! After 15m intermediate stand orographic right (with fixed handrail, recommended), then still R7. The "slide" before the 2nd rappel can be bypassed to the left or to the right at the top. The next step can be done orographic left C10 (exposed chain anchor) or orographic right via rope traverse C20 (chain anchor). T2 at the exit of the canyon is to be checked with regard to the necessary pool depth. orographic. left bolt available or body anchor. 15m after T2 flood protection area.				
Return: (machine translated) At the canyon exit, take the path on the left up to the car.
