Before arriving at Chèze we will see some ruins and a track on the left, we take it and go up it for about 100m and park.		
<b>Approach:</b> (machine translated) From the ruins we continue along the track and further along the path that continues it. Gradually we will see the ravine on the left until the road will approach the stream until we reach almost 800m where we will enter the gorge.

<b>Return:</b> (machine translated) The descent ends after passing the road, we will go left through a meadow to a track that leads us up to the road. Soon we will arrive at the ruins

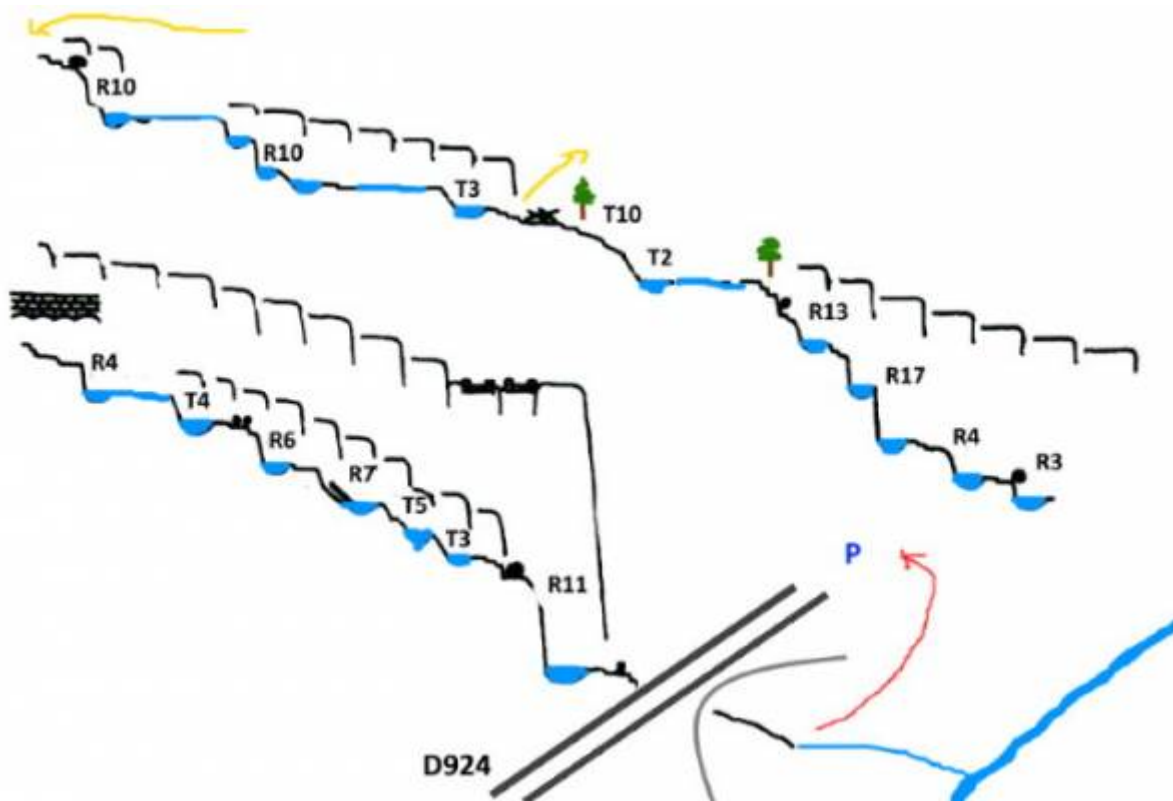
