Summary: (machine translated) rappel canyon; 2 parts with 300m run in between		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) We leave the A8 (Bern - Interlaken) via exit 29 - Brienz, cross the river Aare and turn right 600m further on the museum road to Hofstetten. We later take the Dorfstraße through the center of the village and at its exit we come to Hintere Gasse. Turn left here. Hintere Gasse finds its extension in Stipfigasse and we leave the houses behind us. Across a meadow (a barn on the left) we go towards the edge of the forest. There we turn right at the first building and after about 250m we come to a parking lot for hikers directly at the Eistlenbach. Here we park our car (P - see approach in photo gallery).		
Approach: (machine translated) see map in photo gallery		
Tour: (machine translated) In the first more vertical part, 5 rappels (17-12-21-8-30), then down the creek for about 200m before exiting to the right at the bridge onto the trail. This downhill on the right slope of the stream. Before the narrowing and the 32m high slide brake we climb back into the streambed. After rappelling over the slide brake, 4 more small rappels await us in the impressive gorge. Afterwards we walk about 50m in the off. Streambed downhill and then climb out at the bridge right on the path.		
Return: (machine translated) The path leads down the right bank of the stream and us to the car.

Automatisch importiert von Descente-Canyon.com für Canyon Eistlenbach All anchors ok. Because of the snow, we had some troubles to find the path after crossing the field at approx. 1000 meters. The last 30 meters down to the stream are very steep and slippery. We used ropes around a tree to get down to the stream. All anchors ok (mostly single). Considerable flow due to the rainy weather (see picture), but full flow of the water can largely be avoided in most descents (except 3rd descent). Also 2 large tree trunks in the 3rd rappel. Significant risk of getting ropes stuck. To prevent this, we split the rappel in 2 and used the tree for the second portion of the descend (there is a good ledge to stand halfway down on the right). The faint path to the second section of the canyon begins directly behind the small building 50 m after exit of the first section and follows right side of the stream for approx. 200 meters. Last section very nice and encased (no issues with the flow here). Waterproof jacket highly advised. Overall a beautiful descent under these conditions.
