From the highway connecting Zagreb with Rijeka, take the Ravna Gora exit. Drive towards Delnice and then turn right towards Kupjak and Skrad. Then follow the signs to the hostel: Zeleni Vir. Park in front of the house.

Approach: (machine translated)

You have to pay a fee at the guesthouse. The complex is divided into two parts. The first is Vrajzi Prolav, which you climb up via a footbridge. If you continue to the exit, you will reach a cave that you can climb up until the water becomes too much. For the waterfall (Vodopad), also go up the path that starts to the left of the inn. You can get all the way to the top RD (no equipment). Admire the resurgence gushing at its feet.

Tour: (machine translated)

The most interesting part is after the second bridge with an 8 m high waterfall. At this height, the river is well contained and forms some jumps, which can be playful in deep pools. After this indentation, there are no more interesting obstacles.
