From the town of Basse-Terre on the western half of the island of Guadeloupe of the same name, we take the coastal road (N 2) 22 km (from the airport of Basse-Terre) northward (via the villages of Vieux-Habitants, Bouillante) until we reach the village of Pigeon. At the end of Pigeon we cross the Rivière (= river) Bourceau. About 380 m further on the N2, we turn right in the direction of Birloton. After 750 m (from the N2) the road branches. We turn half-right here (road to the settlement Nègresse and direction Birloton). After about 2 km (from the road junction) this road ends and we park the car here for the access (same parking as for the canyon Bois Malaisé, altitude 290 m above sea level).

At the exit of the road start 2 hiking trails. The left one follows the signpost 'Piton de Bouillante' and is taken in the access to Bois Malaisé. But here we take the path that goes off to the right. It leads us, first uphill, later steeply downhill to the river.

After the 22 m rappel (which can alternatively be done in the stream or dry), climb back up to the left immediately after the cascade (and here you can pull off the rappel from above). On the other side of the stream, there is a large tree on a rocky ledge. Here begins a path that we follow up to the approach road (at a junction we keep left). On the road you walk a good 1 km right up to get the car (for this an additional 15 min.).
