Nothing to report except for three damaged ropes due to a double-rope drop of about 7-8 meters (the starting rope is still usable, though). Not a particularly memorable canyon, with a very steep scree approach. Toward the end, there are 2-3 nice chutes. If you park at Ospitale di Zoldo, there is a fountain where you can clean up and hydrate.
