Situation bcos Guergue and Morro de los Juncos

We will be located in the port of Los Gigantes, where we will leave a vehicle and we will have agreed with a boat of the village the pick up time.

With the access car we will go up to Tamaimo and from there to Santiago del Teide, where we will turn to take the road to Masca (TF436) until the p.k. 20.3, the viewpoint of Masca.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

Access bcos Guergue and Morro de los Juncos

We go down to the next right curve, the Guergues trail comes out in front of us. We will follow this path along the edge of the mountain, with the Masca bank always on the right. Half a kilometer before reaching the cliff we will have the Guergue riverbed on the right.

Access to the Guergue and Morro de los Juncos boulders.

If we continue straight ahead towards the cliff we will descend to the Morro de los Juncos (our ravine) and to the right we will access Guergue.

Dangerous descent with continuous rock falls, the meetings are a few meters on each side of the rope fall to avoid them. They are small meetings with no room for many people and some of them are overhanging.
