Summary: (machine translated) Short access ravine, with quartzite rock. It has two very marked sections, both joined by a path. Two long rappels and more than 5 slides will complete a not very aquatic but very interesting canyon.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) To go to Valdorria we will take the CL626 to La Vecilla. Here we take the LE321 to Lugueros. We pass Valdepiélagos and Montuerto, and soon we arrive at the waterfall of Cola de Caballo. Here there is room to park. We leave the car to return and continue towards Nocedo. From Nocedo there is a road (detour to the left) that goes up to Valdorria, just follow this road and park in the village.		
Approach: (machine translated) Once in the village we will see the cut of the river. We go down to it and walk along the riverbed in the undergrowth or outside (more comfortable).		
Tour: (machine translated) Several slides of 4 and 2 meters before the 20m abseil. Then 3 more fun slides of up to 17m that can be repeated. We will continue along the trail for almost 45 min and then we will enter the river again to rappel to the Cola de Caballo waterfall and its almost 30m.		
Return: (machine translated) Exit directly to the parking lot

Drive 10 minutes, then access the trail for 15 minutes and follow the streambed to the first 2-meter slide; this is followed by a few smaller sections, including a rappel section. Then walk along a trail next to the stream for more than 30 minutes before reaching the final waterfall. The entire "stream" section takes about 2 hours. Not worth the effort on its own; better to plan it as an additional canyon in the area. (machine translated)
