Mostly open canyon with games through multi-layered volcanic rock. Popular option after or during rainfall. Views of the Ocean and arrival on the beach (expect lots of rubbish, possibly contaminated water).

**Hydrology:**

First canyon to catch water, due to a large catchment area and a more impenetrable rockbed.

**Access:**

Park in Iñaza, near the park. Leave no valuables in the car.

**Approach:**

Walk away from the buildings into the open at first, crossing two small river beds before arriving in el Muerto.

**Tour:**

Starts with a jump, followed by a slide and an abseil/jump. A small walking section. A couple higher waterfalls and the final section to the beach. Some handlines to install.

**Return:**

Through the settlement, followed by a cemented track upwards diagonally towards the village, crossing a small canyon. Arriving in town, there's a few steps to the car.

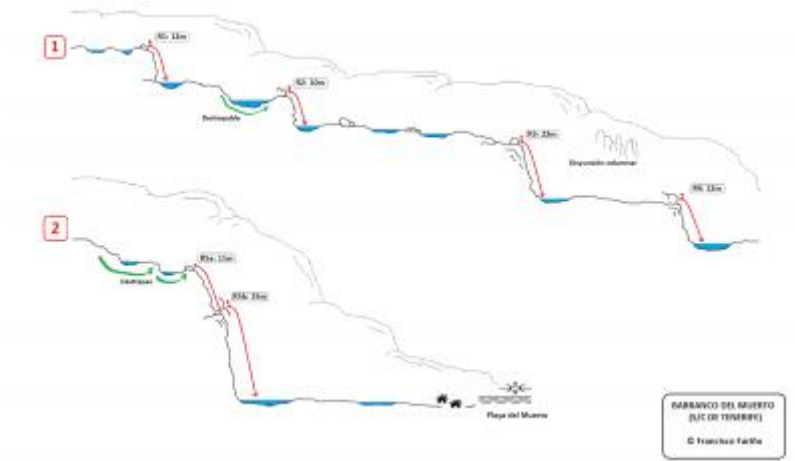
