Access: (machine translated) In someo to one of the hiking campsites at the edge of the forest towards the large maggia bridge.		
Approach: (machine translated) On forest paths to the large Maggia bridge, then on a hiking trail to "a nöstrolcia". https://swisstopo.app/i/5/72G52GUZ		
Tour: (machine translated) 20m anchor right 10m right 15m right to the intermediate stand to the left of the water, then down another 20m 12m anchor right 30m anchor right, in mousetrap. Anchor right and left on top of the rock 35-40 meters into chute, Anchor in the chute on the right, rappel 15 m on it In the same chute, the remaining 30 m on anchors on the right, risk of rope entanglement 15m anchor right Out over boulder terrain Both the mousetrap and the following chute can be technically challenging, depending on the conditions!
