Two simple descents ideal for initiation to canyoning. The Arroyo de Don Ventura has a handrail and a R35 ideal to advance in the practices.

It is also known as the Picapedrero waterfall.

**Hydrology:**

**Access:** (machine translated)

Situating us in Malaga, going north on the street that takes us to the Botanical Garden.

Just at the bridge under the highway, to the left we would go to the botanical garden and to the right to the Picapedreros path, where we will enter. We will park at the end.

**Approach:** (machine translated)

We will leave by the Picapedreros track and when we reach the Picapedreros hut we will have access to the first ravine, Pastelero stream. If we follow the track, once it heads north, we will have the Ventura stream on the right where we would go down to the second ravine.

**Tour:** (machine translated)

Two small descents, the first one for beginners and the second one with a more interesting 35m rappel.

**Return:** (machine translated)

After the R35 we have a path to the right that takes us up to Picapedreros. Or in both cases we can follow the riverbed to a path that leads us to the uphill track.

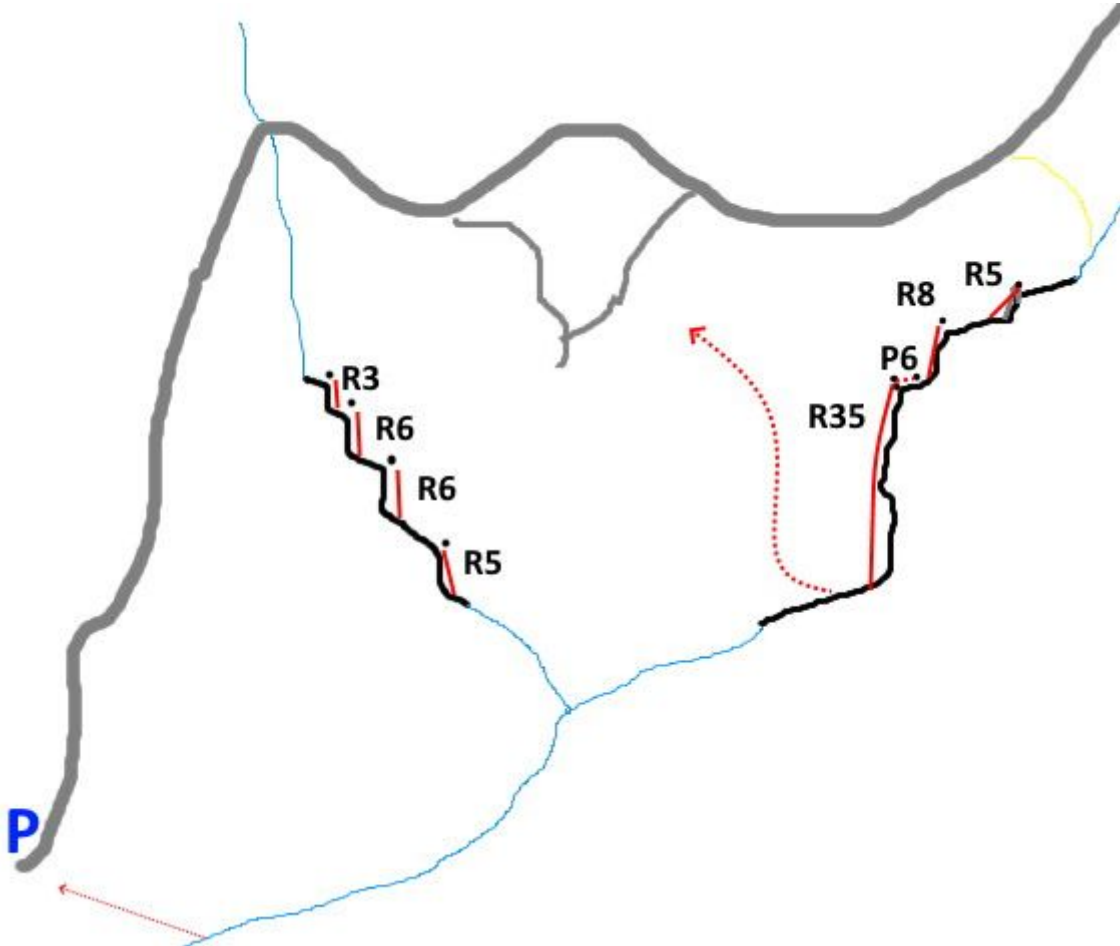
