Summary: (machine translated) Beautiful aquatic granite gorge; automatic bedload barrier that can open at any time; info and permission for ascents at Alpinsport Koller (Tel: +436505545776); siphon in the middle section (dangerous only at high water level); most rappelling points are in the watercourse; most beautiful sunlight in the afternoon; well equipped; for rope retrieval a 40m rope is recommended.		
Hydrology:		
Access: (machine translated) approx. 10-15min From the Tauernautobahn A10 take the exit Gmünd. After the traffic circle follow the Maltatal Landestrasse L12 to the large Fallbach parking lot. At the exit of the parking lot turn left and cross the small bridge over the Malta river. After the Pension Jahn keep to the right at the junction. In a short time you reach the Gössgraben parking lot. Park here. The shuttle car is not necessary for this tour. (With shuttle car follow the road after the Pension Jahn straight up to the bridge. Parking is possible on the left after the bridge.)		
Approach: (machine translated) approx. 20min Follow the trail on the orographic left side of the canyon. Here you have the possibility to have a look into the canyons. At 980m one climbs before the bridge on the left into the stream. ! The actual amount of water in the canyon should be judged at the bridge (entry), because before the bridge the water is diverted and after the exit is fed again!		
Tour: (machine translated) about 2,5h Depending on the water passage, the difficulty in the canyon increases. The first steps are often overcome under the watchful eye of curious hikers. Without a long way, several rappelling points follow, some of which can also be jumped or slid. In the canyons you always have the possibility to bypass rappelling points or to find a safe place in case of a water rise. However, the canyons should not be underestimated. The last waterfall is the highest. Here you reach a tree on the right via a fixed traversese rope from which 12m can be rappelled or, in large pools, jumped. Exit on the right next to the viewing platform (870m).		
Return: (machine translated) ca.5 min From the viewing platform follow the trail down to the parking lot.
