Very slippery, between the belay in the high abseil (last one) consists of four moderately good holds, which are completely flooded at this water level. (machine translated)

Good alternative if the weather is uncertain. Shuttle (car replacement) with 7chf ride and parking ticket possible. Slippery in the rappels. Some wood in the walking passages. A boulder field with a lot of very loose rock has to be descended. Anchors all still quite good, except in the intermediate belay in the large final step. There four single pitons, partly bent, had to be tightened. (machine translated)
